### Frequently Asked Questions....

### Where do I get the information required for such an assessment?

Triple "A" Driver Training Centre will supply you with all the resource material and application forms.

### Who will conduct this assessment?

Triple "A" Driver Training Centres assessor will conduct the assessment from their office in Newlands.

### What type of assessment is it?

This is a combination of practical and theoretical assessments.

The theoretical part of the assessment is **closed book**, which means you are **not permitted** to take the hand book into the assessment with you but will have to show the assessor that you understand its content.

### What marks will I need to achieve to pass?

The assessments are unit standard based and require that you complete them to competency standard of 100%

### Do I get the results at the conclusion of the assessment?

You will receive the results as you progress through the course, and once competent, you will receive an original certificate which you then take into a licensing agent to have included on your licence.

# AAA Class 2 approved Course

To complete the approved Class 2 course with Triple "A" you need to sit and pass your Class 2 learners licence.

To obtain a Class 2 learner licence you must...........

- Have held a full class 1 (car licence) for at least 6 months.
- pass the theory test, which consists of 25 general road code questions and 10 specialist truck questions (The cost of this is \$91.90 payable to the licencing agency)
- supply a completed "Medical certificate" (DL9 form) from your doctor which you will need to produce on application for your learners licence.

Learner licence course materials – including the road code, are available from Triple "A" on request. You can apply for and sit your Class 2 Learners Licence at a driver Licencing Agency (eg VTNZ Adelaide Rd Newtown or Seaview Lower Hutt, AA centres, VINZ Parliament St Lower Hutt)

When you have your Class 2 Learners Licence you can begin the approved course.

Once you have completed the approved course and unit standard assessments to competency standard you will be issued with a certificate. To have the Class 2 put onto your licence you will need to take this certificate to a licencing agency along with:

- your drivers licence
- proof of residency (bank statement, or bill of some sort, showing your address)
- Licence Fee (currently \$44.00 but subject to change)

# What's involved and how long will it take to complete?

- Attend two 5 hour study workshops for each of your unit standards.
- Package includes two 1 hour- 1 ½ hour practice sessions (depending on your training needs) in a Class 2 vehicle at Triple "A" (Extra lessons are available at \$85)
- $\bullet$  1 ½ 2 hours will be needed for each assessment.
- Your final practical & theory assessment will take 2 hours.

Triple "A" will provide the truck for training and assessment, unless you specifically would like to use your own. (There will be requirements to have this loaded to half its pay load).

It usually takes 2-4 weeks to complete the entire Class 2 licencing course; depending on the dates of the workshop classes.

## What costs are involved?

The cost of the course and all materials/handbooks is **\$895.00** (incl GST) (Proof of New Zealand residency will be required)

Extra lessons if required are \$95 p/h

Re-sit fees for theory assessments per unit standard questionnaire is \$80.00; to re-sit the 5 day logbook scenario is \$50.00 for practical assessment is \$120.00

Deposits and fees paid will be held for a period of 3 months. If not used within that time, then new course fees will apply.

### Refunds

On request for cancellation of an examination, 80% of the original fee paid will be refunded. The cancellation request must be made more than 5 working days before the scheduled sitting date. No refund will be made otherwise
