

HT CLASS 2 OR 4 LICENCING

HOW DO I GET A CLASS 2 LICENCE?

To complete the approved Class 2 course with Triple “A” you need to sit and pass your Class 2 **learners licence**.

To obtain a Class 2 learner licence you must...

- Have held a **full** class 1 (*car licence*) for **at least 6 months**.
- Pass the **theory test**, which consists of 25 general road code questions and 10 specialist truck questions (*The cost of this is \$91.90 payable to the licensing agency*)
- supply a completed **“Medical certificate”** (*DL9 form*) from your doctor which you will need to produce on application for your learners licence.

Learner licence course materials – including the road code, are available from Triple “A” on request. You can apply for and sit your Class 2 Learners Licence at a driver Licensing Agency (eg **VTNZ** Adelaide Rd Newtown or Seaview Lower Hutt, **AA** centres, **VINZ** Parliament St Lower Hutt)

When you have your Class 2 Learners Licence you can begin the *approved course*. Once you have completed the approved course and unit standard assessments to competency standard you will be issued with a certificate. To have the Class 2 put onto your licence you will need to take this certificate to a licensing agency along with:

- your drivers licence
- proof of residency (bank statement, or bill of some sort, showing your address)
- Licence Fee (currently \$44.00 but subject to change)

WHATS INVOLVED IN THE APPROVED COURSE?

You are required to attend two full day workshops—one for the Class 2 unit standard and one for the fatigue management, work time & driver log book requirements. The written assessments are conducted at the end of each workshop.

You will be given two 1 ½ hour practice drive sessions in a Class 2 vehicle at Triple “A” (Extra lessons are available at \$95) Your final practical assessment will take 2 hours.

Triple “A” will provide the truck for training & assessment, unless you specifically would like to use your own. (*required to have this loaded to half its pay load*).

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO COMPLETE?

It usually takes 2-4 weeks to complete the entire Class 2 licensing course; depending on the dates of the workshop classes.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The cost of the course and all materials/handbooks is **\$895.00** (incl GST) (*Proof of New Zealand residency will be required*)

Extra lessons if required are \$95 p/h

Re-sit fees:

- Theory assessments per unit standard questionnaire is \$80.00
- 5 day logbook scenario is \$50.00
- Practical assessment is \$120.00



HOW DO I GET A CLASS 4 LICENCE?

To be eligible to obtain a class 4 licence you must have held a **Class 2 full licence** for **6 months** if you're **under 25** years or **3 months** if you're **over 25**.

If you completed an **approved course** for the Class 2 licence (& can provide evidence of completion) you will not be required to undergo the theory training component of the class 4—you will only have to complete the practical training & assessment.

If you have not completed an approved course then you will be required to do so—the course is structured the same as the class 2 (*to the left*).

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

To do the **full approved class 4 course** (*if you have not already done an approved course for class 2*) is **\$895** (incl. GST)

If you only require the practical training & assessment for the class 4 it's **\$495** (incl. GST)

HOW LONG DOES IT TAKE TO COMPLETE?

If you are doing the approved course it will take roughly 2 weeks (*depending on scheduled course dates*) - if you're only doing the practical element it will take 1-2 days.
